Earliest records of Baptisms and Marriages in northern Van Diemens Land


There are not systematic and continuous records of religious events, including baptisms, marriages and burials, predating the establishment of St. John's Church. There is some evidence of such events, but our earliest listing dates from 1811, mainly covering that year and 1815, but with a reference to 1815. The listing suggests this was a summary prepared by Revd. Robert Knopwood, perhaps from his own papers, and has come down to us through the papers of Revd. W.H. Browne, rector from 1828 to 1868. Knopwood lived on until 1838, and it is quite possible that he prepared

this list at Browne's request.
