The Chalice the John Youl used, was given to St John's Church Launceston, in about 1965, by my father, Hubert Lewis

It came to him at the death of his mother Lady Lewis.

Here is the providence of the Chalice:

1... The Revd John Youl, (1777 – 1827) original owner of the Chalice

There is no known information as to where he obtained it. Probably he brought it with him when he came to Tasmania in 1819.

2... John's son: (Sir) James Arndell Youl

3. John Grandson : Charles Youl


4. John's Great-Great Grand-daughter Lina Henrietta Youl (Later: Lady Lewis) (Known as Etta)

5. John's Great Great Great Grand-son : Hubert Lewis

6 St John's Church , Launceston.
