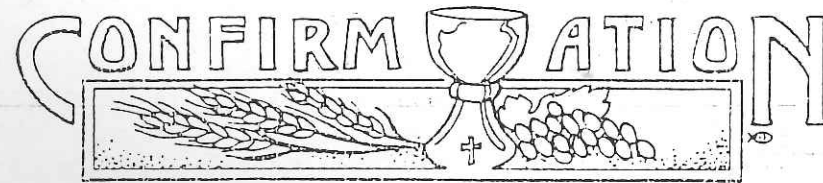

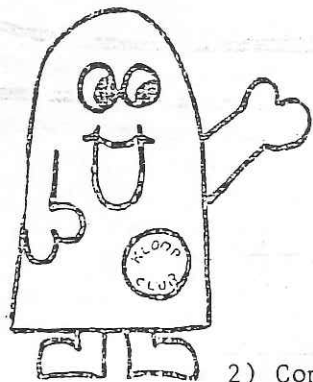

Dear friends,

The Annual Meeting was a notable event of encouragement, thanksgiving to the Lord for His goodness, and affirming of our Primary Purpose as set out at the Parish Consultation in February. As a vote of confidence, the previous Vestry was voted back into office. Those elected to other positions are listed elsewhere. We assure them of our prayers, love and thanks for their willingness to serve.

The Annual Meeting decided to forward \$5,000 from the Beck Bequest to the Anglican Family Care Services in Launceston to help in its "Debt Help" ministry to the needy. We also decided to wait on the Lord in faith for the provision of necessary finances to provide parish ministry. Our urgent target is \$1,500 offertory each week. What a challenge!
