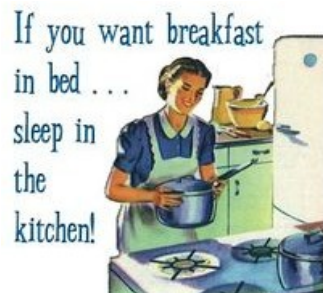


Mumisms

The next class the professor handed the tests back out. This student got back his test and \$56 change.

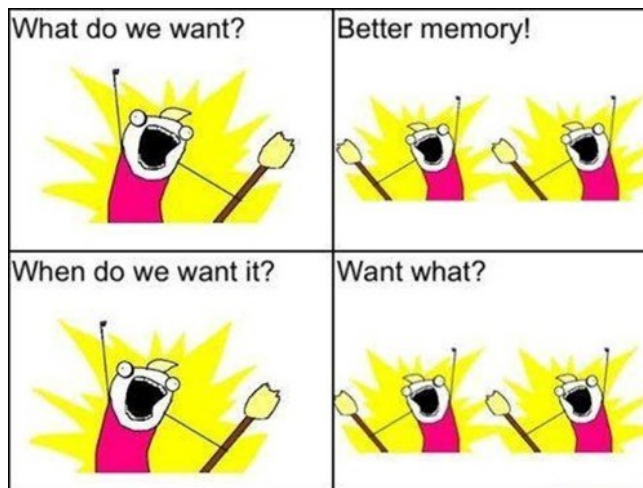
A man was seen fleeing down the hall of the hospital just before his operation.

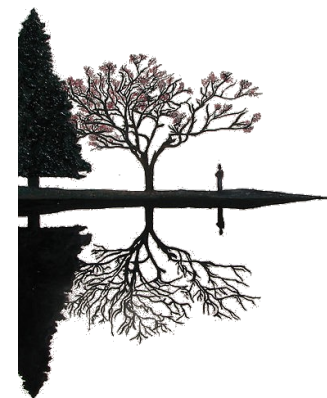
