In the last week, the Registrar and I have been visiting the Parishes most affected by the proposed property sales to fund Redress. We have visited Wynyard, Penguin, Quamby, Sheffield, Sth Launceston, St Leonard's and Cressy to present the plan and answer questions. The mood has been very sombre as there is great sadness, but in all but one place the plan has been accepted with gracious and prayerful support. We have been most humbled by it, and the deep maturity of God's people. There is quiet joy in Parishes where they know that by their sacrifice, hurting people will find support. It was wonderful to worship with the saints in St Leonard's on Sunday. I also had two days of meetings with the General Synod Standing Committee in Sydney, where the topic of the National Redress Scheme was high on the Agenda.

I am deeply sad to report that last week the Anglican Church in New Zealand rejected the doctrine of the Anglican church and the teaching of Christ, and changed their canons to allow Bishop's to authorise the blessing of same-sex unions. Please join me in praying for their repentance.

Please join me in giving thanks to God for:

- Our Parishes as they respond to the plan to support redress.
- The prayerful concerned response for survivors of sexual abuse.
- The hard work of the national church on this issue. Please pray for:
- Our Diocese as we grapple with our redress responsibilities, and for Parishes as they work out how to respond.
- Our Synod members as they prepare to work very hard on the proposed legislation, and the pre-Synod briefings this week.
- The Anglican Church in New Zealand, that they might turn back to Christ.
